CATC

- The Croatian Association of Technical Culture (CATC)
 - the highest national institution in the field of technical culture in the Republic of Croatia
 - consists today of 18 national associations, 19 county and 36 city technical culture communities
 - more than 600 associations of technical culture with over 60.000 members
 - In the year of 2021. it marked 75 years of its activity with numerous manifestations and festivities

Financing

- The Republic of Croatia has two laws that are very important for technical culture
 - the Law on Technical Culture
 - The Law on the Croatian Lottery
- CATC is financed from the budget of the Republic of Croatia according to the Law on the Croatian Lottery

Basic Tasks

- stimulate and promote all the activities of technical culture
- participate in articulating the policy for promotion of technical culture
- propose the public needs programs of the Republic of Croatia in the field of technical culture
- harmonize the activities of national associations in technical culture in the realization of the development of technical culture
- stimulate research and care for the education of employees in technical culture
- develop extra-curricular and extra-educational activities of children and youth
- educate and qualify citizens and publish materials

Modeling league

- Team competition for students in the field of wood modeling
- It conducts in all 21 counties in Republic of Croatia
- It is carried out in cooperation with the Croatian Association of Technical Culture Pedagogues, county and city associations of technical culture, associations of technical culture pedagogues and primary schools

Beginnings of the Modeling League

- The league was launched at the beginning of the 2012./2013. school year
- Teams from 6 counties that held the county competition were included, plus teams from three counties by invitation
- For two years, CATC held workshops in all counties and allocated equipment and material for training and educational work
- Today, all 21 counties are included in the competition

MODELING ASIA LIGA

ML 2022./2023.

- A total of 1,325 students from 264 elementary schools and 19 technical culture associations passed through the county and school levels, under the guidance of 253 mentors
- 27 students with disabilities participated in the competition, 8 of whom also competed at the state level
- At the state level of the Modeling League, 58 students from all counties of the Republic of Croatia took part, led by 31 mentors

Implementation of ML

- During the year, teachers and mentors conduct workshops in schools and technical culture associations
- The best students perform at school and county competitions
- Teams of students with disabilities also participate in the competition
- Teams consist of two students each
- At the school and county level, the competition lasts 180 minute
- The best teams from county competitions perform at the state level
- CATC provides materials and prepares drafts of works for the competition
- CATC also provides machines safe for children, for the competitions where they are needed

Nacional level of the Modeling League

- Up to 30 teams
- 21 teams from county competitions
- Up to 5 teams of students with disabilities
- Additional teams according to the number of students at school and county competitions
- The national level is conducted from Friday to Sunday
 - On Friday is the arrival and accommodation of the teams
 - The competition itself takes place on Saturday
 - On Sunday, the announcement is made and the return home
- The competition itself lasts 240 minutes
- CATC provides all materials and templates for the work
- CATC provides transportation to the competition venue and accommodation
- CATC selects 5 to 7 judges for the state level



Prizes

- AT the state level, CATC awards three first-placed teams, their mentors and schools or associations with valuable prizes
- CATC also awards the best team of students with disabilities
- As an additional prize, the students of the first-placed team win participation in the Summer School of technical activities
